

GETTING TO KNOW HTML

THE HTML SPECIFICATION

HTML is designed by the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C)

The HTML 5 specification is

<http://www.w3.org/TR/html5/>

If you are a beginner, don't go there!

ATTRIBUTES

You need to use speech marks for any HTML attributes:

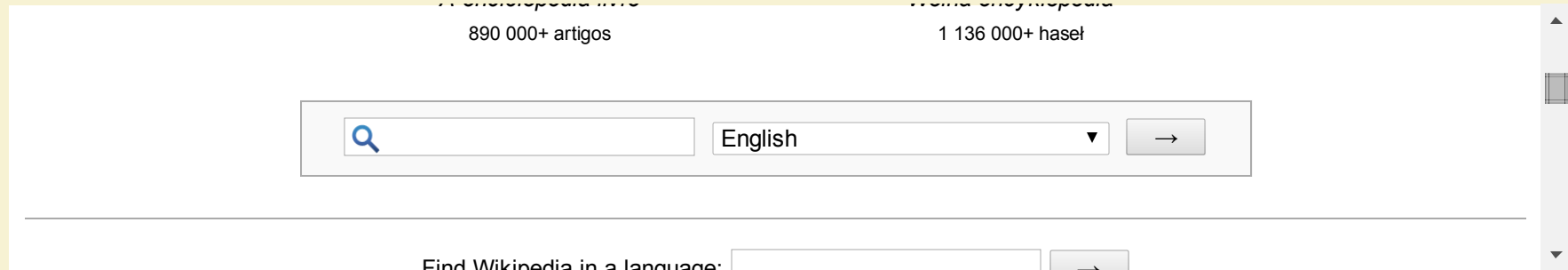
```
<meta name="author" content="David Rossiter">
```

Double speech marks " and single speech marks ' are both OK:

```
<meta name='author' content='David Rossiter'>
```
